




ASH SURREY



Getting around from Heatherwell Place is refreshingly straightforward, with no city traffic to contend with.

The A31 is a few minutes' drive, giving you easy access to surrounding towns, the south coast and the M25. The M3 is a 10-minute drive away for travelling south and west, or into London.

Rail travel from Heatherwell Place is an easy option too. Ash rail station is a 10-minute walk away, making it a great choice for commuters. The journey to London Waterloo takes 53 minutes with a change at Guildford station, or head out to Reading in 33 minutes, another large business and commercial hub.




TRAVEL WITH EASE

HEATHERWELL PLACE

Wonderful views, magical woodland, grassy hills ... you're surrounded by inspiring places to explore at Heatherwell Place.

Less than a mile away is Blackwater Valley footpath, giving you easy access to the riverside walking and running route. It covers a total distance of 22 miles, passing through woodland and flower-rich meadows, so you can walk for as long (or as little) as you want.

The North Downs are a short drive or bike ride away, the hilly ridge of the Hog's Back offering spectacular views over the countryside. Puttenham Common, a 16 minute drive from Heatherwell Place, is a paradise for birds and butterflies with its ponds, swathes of beautiful heather and wooded areas of oak and Scots pine. A little further south, you'll find Hankley Common and Thursley Nature Reserve, with numerous cycling, walking and horse riding routes for an invigorating day out in the fresh air. And if you prefer to get active on the water, the stunning Frensham Great Pond nearby has its own sailing club.





THE GLORIOUS OUTDOORS

Alice Holt Forest and Birdworld, both in Farnham, are fun choices for family trips, while the ruins of Waverley Abbey make for a photogenic stop next to the River Wey. You can also enjoy a sporting lifestyle at Heatherwell Place, with plenty of clubs and activities located close enough for you to easily fit them into your weekend. Play a round of golf at nearby Farnham Golf Club or Puttenham Golf Club; practise your tennis strokes at clubs in Ash, Badshot Lea and Eggars Hill; or boost your fitness levels at David Lloyd Farnham Health Club, with a gym, swimming pool, spa, tennis courts and children's club. For a less active but highly competitive day out, Ascot Racecourse is a 22 minute drive away.



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YOUR STYLE OF SHOPPING

Heatherwell Place is perfectly positioned for you to enjoy some of Surrey's most appealing towns.

Guildford combines historic charm with serious retail therapy as designer brands, high street favourites and independent boutiques rub shoulders on its cobbled streets. Anthropologie, Oka, Loaf, Cos and Jo Malone are just some of the names you'll find there, as well as an Odeon multiplex cinema, two theatres, live entertainment venue and numerous bars and restaurants.


Farnham is an attractive market town with a creative spirit. Home to the University of Creative Arts, it also has a number of independent spaces such as The Farnham Pottery where you can take part in workshops and events, and arts centre Farnham Maltings, as well as a range of shops, cafés and restaurants.

Travel a little further through the countryside and you'll reach Godalming, another pocket of charm to explore, with its own museum, galleries, boutiques, stores and pubs nestled amongst historic buildings.





LONG LUNCHES AND EVENINGS OUT





Looking for a night out with friends, gourmet food, or somewhere to relax with the whole family? There's plenty to choose from when you live at Heatherwell Place.

Favourite pubs in the area include The Princess Royal with its stylish, welcoming bar and dining room. Located just on the edge of the North Downs, it's a great place to start or finish a country walk. The Spotted Cow, just outside Farnham, is another gem, set in secluded woodland with four acres of grounds – perfect for summer lunches.

Guildford is a good choice for a night out with its range of restaurants including The Ivy, Franco Manca, Bill's, Giggling Squid and Côte. Blue Sardinia is a family-run Italian restaurant, cooking up a mix of modern and traditional dishes, while The March Hare offers a French brasserie menu in a cosy pub environment. If you're looking for evening drinks, there are many convivial pubs, such as the George Abbot and The White House by the river; The Long Bar is an elegant spot for cocktails, live music and dancing; and Komo is a buzzy, award-wining independent bar.

A PLACE TO LEARN

There's a good reason why this area is popular with families: great schools. The Walsh Memorial C of E Infant School is rated 'Outstanding' by Ofsted, while Ash Manor School for secondary age pupils is rated 'Good'. Alderwood School in Aldershot, which takes pupils from age five to 16, is also rated 'Outstanding'.

Independent schools include Guildford High School for girls aged four to 18, and the Royal Grammar School for boys aged 11 to 18, also in Guildford. Closer to Heatherwell Place is Salesian College in Farnborough, a Roman Catholic secondary school for boys with a co-educational sixth form, while Barfield School in Farnham is for girls and boys aged two to 13.










HOW TO FIND US



From the M3:

At Junction 4, take the A331 exit to Guildford. At the roundabout, take the second exit onto the A331. Continue on the A331, then take the A323 exit towards Aldershot/Woking. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Aldershot Road/A323, then at the next roundabout go straight on. Turn right onto Grange Road and right again onto South Lane and continue until you reach Heatherwell Place.

From the M25:

At Junction 10, take the A3 exit to Portsmouth/ Guildford/Effingham. Continue along the A3, then use the left lane to merge onto Farnham Road/A31. Turn off the A31 onto the A331. Take the A323 exit towards Aldershot/Woking. Continue on the A323, then at the next roundabout go straight on. Turn right onto Grange Road and right again onto South Lane and continue until you reach Heatherwell Place.

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
